## Sports Premium – Statement of Impact

The sports premium grant has hugely benefited all of the children at Hartburn Primary School. For 2014/2015 Hartburn Primary received £10,000. The funding has been used in areas which improve and enhance the sporting experiences offered. We have allocated money into these main areas:

- Investment in Staff Skills and Training – Silver Package
- Investment in Outdoor Facilities
- Transport to Competitions and Festivals
- Investment in extended opportunities

### **Investment in Staff Skills and Training – Silver Package**

The impact of quality first teaching on children is important and we recognise this by buying into the Stockton School Sports Partnership (SSSP) Gold Package. This provides subject leadership training, CPD courses for staff, CPD days to develop staff and children, access to competitions and access to additional resources for staff. The subject leader training has enabled newly appointed co-ordinators to become aware of the new primary PE curriculum and how to introduce it into our large school.

### **Investment in Outdoor Facilities**



Outdoor games lessons were increasingly reduced during periods of bad weather. The field could be out of use for weeks and lessons were restricted to the yard area. A new, Multi Use Games Area (MUGA) was installed in place of the grass area in Key Stage 2. The astro turf surface has a multitude of lines and markings cut into it. These include: a 4 lane running track, tennis courts and hockey pitches. These markings save valuable lesson time due to pitches not needing to be marked.

This has led to a huge increase in outdoor PE lessons which can be delivered on a high quality, safe surface. This facility is enjoyed by all year groups from Nursery through to Year 6. In addition to this, playtimes, lunchtimes and extra-curricular clubs also reap the rewards of this surface, giving our children lots more space to enjoy being active.
