
Y3/4 Summer Newsletter



In the Emperors and Empires topic, your child will learn about the Roman hierarchy, the significant growth of the empire and the enormous Roman army. They will look at significant events, religions and people such as Boudicca, Hadrian's Wall and Christianity. They will discover terminology relating to time and sequence dates to make a timeline. Pupils will explore the changes Romans made to people, homes and lifestyle. They will also study how inventions improved the way that people lived.

English - Pupils will be writing myths, biographies, letters and poems. Please support us with reading, by regularly listening to your child read aloud at home. Your child can also access different texts on reading plus.

Maths - Pupils will continue to develop their fluency and reasoning skills through solving problems using all four operations. Year 3 will also be learning about fractions, money, time shape and statistics. Year 4 will be learning about decimals, money, time, statistics, position and direction and shape. Please support us at home by ensuring your child complete their maths homework.

Science – Pupils will learn about light and shadows and Plant Nutrition and Reproduction.

PE - Pupils will be developing their orienteering skills, practising their map reading skills and teamwork.

History – Pupils will learn about the Roman conquest and significant figures such as Julius Caesar and Boudicca.

Art and Design – Pupils will be creating observational drawings of famous landmarks.

Design Technology – Pupils will learn about greenhouses. They will design and create their own mini greenhouses after learning about how structures can be made stronger.

Computing – Pupils will be using technology to edit photographs.

Music - Pupils will learn about the rhythm, beat and the structure of songs.

Art and DT:_Pupils will learn about botanicals and mosaics. They will create beautiful botanical looms using plants found in the school playground.
