In this term our KS1 project is called Bright Lights, Big City. This project teaches children about the physical and human characteristics of the United Kingdom, including a detailed exploration of the characteristics and features of the capital city, London.

English - Pupils will be writing instructions, stories, and information posters. Please support us with reading, by regularly listening to your child read aloud at home and signing their reading record. Remember, you can access lots of books on Oxford Owl too.

Maths - Pupils will continue to develop their fluency and reasoning skills through solving problems using all four operations. Children will also be learning about measuring length, height, weight and volume. Please support us at home by ensuring your child completes their maths homework.

Science – Pupils will learn about seasons, seasonal changes and typical seasonal weather and events.

PE - Pupils will be developing their ball skills, using their feet to maintain control in dribbling, passing and shooting.

Geography – Pupils will learn about cities and will compare cities in the UK with cities around the world.

History – Pupils will learn about the Monarchy and The Great Fire of London.

Art and Design – Pupils will be creating observational drawings of famous landmarks.

Design Technology – Pupils will learn about wheels, axles and chassis and how they work together to make a vehicle move.

Computing – Pupils will be using technology to create music.

Music – Pupils will learn about the rhythm, beat and the structure of songs.
